

2019 REUNION


The following cities have been suggested for the 2019 reunion:

On 02/05/18

Received a phone call from *Robert Two Bulls 52-54 SN*. Robert had some good suggestions for different things the reunion group could do while in Rapid City but all tours had been finalized by the time we spoke. Robert originally thought he would be able to attend the reunion but told me in another phone call that he wouldn't be able to attend. Hopefully that has changed and he'll be able to join the group in September.

On 02/26/18

Hi Charlie & Kim, I hope this finds you both well. As you may or may not know, Rick has had a lot of medical issues that have complicated our lives for several years now. He is now completely blind in both eyes, has a heart condition, is diabetic and also has advanced COPD. Last November he was diagnosed with Lung Cancer, and thanks to radiation, that has gone. On top of all this, on October 31st, 2016 Rick had surgery for an Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm, which they knew about for years, but it didn't get big enough to operate on till Oct/2016. Immediately following the surgery Rick developed a psychosis which they thought was a postoperative condition and would go away. That was a year and a half ago, and he still has the psychosis. I am telling you all this because some of his doctors thought he was exposed to Agent Orange, and that some of these conditions were due to it. We've applied several times for financial aid, but denied because the crew from the Radford never stepped on the soil in Vietnam. I am writing you to see if anyone else from the Radford, who was in Vietnam, has or had anything similar to what Rick is/has experienced. From the newsletters over the years, a lot of the Radford Crew who were in Vietnam have passed away. If you could help me with any information you may have or heard, I would greatly appreciate it. I am also working with a private attorney, through the VA, who, along with other VA and private attorney's across the country assisting veterans who like those on the Radford were exposed to Agent Orange in Vietnam, Okinawa, etc. A case is in the works for going to the Supreme Court to help the many veterans exposed to this horrible agent.
