Good News! The Radford is included in the list of Blue Water Navy Ships eligible for Agent Orange exposure coverage in the Veterans Administration. The US Navy has determined that Blue Water Navy veterans are now entitled to a presumption of service connection for conditions related to Agent Orange exposure. This will be very encouraging for any of you who may have been on board Radford when she operated in Ganh Rai Bay and Saigon River during December 1967. Details are at the VA website:
